

Our Hebrew School, like many others, is changing the course of Hebrew reading with an innovative reading system. Based on the martial arts motivational philosophy of color-coded levels and testing, the Aleph Champion program provides our students with clear goals, motivation and a world of inspiration.

White Aleph: Master the first 18 letters of the Aleph Bet. Red

Red Aleph: Master all 32 letters of the Aleph Bet.

Orange Aleph: Master the first 3 vowels with letter

combinations.

Yellow Aleph: Master the first 6 vowels with letter

combinations.

Green Aleph: Master the first 9 vowels with letter

combinations.

Blue Aleph: Master all the vowels and exceptions to the rules.

Purple Aleph: Master reading familiar Prayers and Brachot.

Brown Aleph: Master reading important Tefillot.

Grey Aleph: Master reading from the Siddur in a timed

fashion.

Black Aleph: Master reading over 100 words in a minute.
